Suburban Rail Loop in Glen Waverley: build it and build it right

Following our last update in June, Council received a huge amount of feedback on the proposed Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) station in Glen Waverley. Over 700 people completed our survey and 150 people attended our information session. Thank you to everyone who took part.

Overwhelmingly our community told us that you agree with Council's position that the Suburban Rail Loop is a game changer for transport in Victoria and for shaping Glen Waverley's future.

However, you also told us that if the Victorian Government is going to build it - **they should build it right**, and that you share our key concerns of the project's design:

- That the existing Glen Waverley station should be undergrounded with a direct pedestrian connection to the new SRL station.
- That Myrtle Street should be extended to create a ring road to support Council's long-term vision for a more pedestrian friendly environment on Kingsway.
- That off-street parking options need to be considered close to businesses in Kingsway.

The time for this vision for Glen Waverley's future to be delivered is now, as part of the SRL project – instead of being short sighted. It is not enough for the Victorian Government to say this will be considered in the future.

Council has advocated on this for a long time, and **now we need your help**. Before November's Victorian election you may be visited by candidates at your house, called on the phone or approached at the shops. Tell them you support SRL in Glen Waverley, but **if we're going to build it, build it right**.

Ask them:

- How will they ensure the SRL project creates a future thriving Glen Waverley?
- What will they do to ensure the SRL station connects underground with the existing Glen Waverley station without street closures?
- How can we save Kingsway from more traffic so it can be made more pedestrian friendly?
- How the SRL Authority will ensure there is car parking available close to our businesses?
